GUIDANCE FOR PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION

Below you will find questions to be used as guidance by a licensed psychologist or psychiatrist to qualify prospective Resident for the Armed Forces Retirement Home (AFRH). The Director, AFRH requires a full assessment be done by a qualified authority for the purpose of assessing the ability of the prospective Resident to live in our social setting which is dormitory style living quarters.

- Does the individual have any psychiatric history?
- Specifically, has the individual been on any psychiatric medications during the last five years?
- Have there been any psychiatric hospitalizations?
- Is there any family history of dementia/Alzheimer's, psychosis, depression or other psychiatric illnesses?
- Is there a history of substance abuse? If so, what is the current status?
- Is this person able to function in a social environment without being a danger to self or others?
- Is there any reason to believe that this person is limited in their activities of daily living?
- Is this individual able to handle his/her own finances at this time without assistance?
