Resident Cost: \$8 Admission (Pay @ Bus) (Sign up by 31 AUG in Rec Svcs)

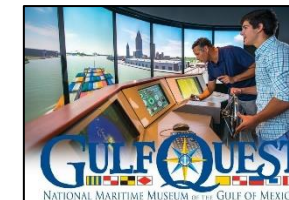
