- **TECH SAFETY TIP OF THE WEEK:** If you receive an unexpected call, email, or text asking for personal or financial information, take a moment to pause before responding. Scammers often try to create urgency or appear official to get you to act quickly. Do not click links, open attachments, or share information right away. Instead, verify the request by contacting the organization directly using a phone number or website you trust.
- **TAX SEASON IS APPROACHING:** Keesler Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) services will be on site at AFRH-G on select days from February through April to assist residents with tax preparation services beginning on 11FEB. Additional dates will be announced soon. Sign-up sheets are located at Recreation Services. Appointments are 20-30 minutes each. - **NEW GATE PROCEDURES:** We are beginning a soft opening of the new gate system. During this time, residents & staff should use the right entrance lane and present their badge to the security guard, while guests & volunteers should enter through the left entrance lane. Once the soft opening period ends, residents & staff will swipe their access key to access the property in the right entrance lane. No action is required to exit the property, as the exit gate arms will open automatically for each vehicle. Please do not follow closely behind another car when exiting; the gate arm will lower after each vehicle. Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we transition to the new gate system.
- **GENERAL DRESS CODE:** Clothing must be clean and neat. The following are not permitted: tank-top undershirts, short shorts, bedroom slippers, shower shoes, pajamas, or bathrobes. Shoes or sandals must be worn. Urinary collection bags/tubing must be covered. Hats may be worn but should not be placed on tables or food service areas.
