RESIDENT BIKES: Residents who store a bicycle in the garage must confirm their bike registration by April 10 with Recreation. Please contact Colette, Lead Rec. Specialist, in Office 1208, by phone at 897-4434, or by email at colette.byrnese@afrh.gov. Be sure to provide your bike registration number and confirm that your bike is actively being used. Several bikes currently do not have registration stickers or appear unusable due to damage or flat tires. To help keep the garage organized and safe, all bikes must be registered and in use. Please note that only registered bikes can receive service in the bike shop; work cannot be completed on unregistered bicycles. Unregistered or damaged bikes not claimed by April 10 will be inspected and every effort made to locate an owner. Unclaimed bikes will be donated or disposed of in coordination with Campus Operations, with the process beginning no earlier than late April.
