CURRENT ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- **MEDICAL APPOINTMENT TRANSPORTATION REQUESTS:** Residents are required to provide a minimum of 48 hours’ notice for transport requests. We highly recommend that you inform the Scheduler immediately upon receipt of an appointment; don’t wait. Transportation is space available with priority given to residents who are unable to drive. - **SWIMMING POOL:** The swimming pool is now open for the season! Residents are welcome to enjoy the pool during regular facility hours (0600 – 2200). Please note that no lifeguard is on duty, so residents swim at their own risk. Residents and guests must be appropriately dressed when traveling to and from the pool area—bathing suits must be covered when outside the pool deck. Pool buddy hours will be posted when available.
