CURRENT ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- WELLNESS CENTER AND MEDICATIONS: Bring all medications to Sick Call and to every appointment. Primary Care Providers are required to review each medication at each visit. Bring all prescription medications, eye drops, inhalers, ointments, vitamins, supplements and other products you purchased. If you are unable to retrieve your medications in a timely manner, the Provider may direct that your appointment be rescheduled.
- REAL ID: Starting May 7, 2025, the federal government requires a REAL ID for domestic air travel and entry into some federal buildings. If your driver's license doesn't have a star, it's likely not compliant. A passport or military ID will also work. Visit your DMV to upgrade and avoid travel disruptions. More info: dhs.gov/real-id
