- ➤ DON'T RUN OUT OF MEDICATIONS: Residents are responsible to ensure that they have a fourteen (14) day minimum supply of medications at all times. It usually takes (5) business days to process medication requests from when they are dropped off (excluding federal holiday and weekends). We don't offer same day Wellness Clinic appointments for prescription renewals so plan accordingly and schedule an appointment before you run out. This is especially important during Hurricane Season.
- ➤ TECH SAFETY TIP OF THE WEEK: Be cautious of unexpected emails, texts, or phone calls asking for personal information. If you're unsure, don't click links or share details. Instead, contact the company or person directly using a trusted phone number.
