COVID NOTE OF THE WEEK:

COVID-19 is the disease caused by the spread of SARSCoV-2, which is transmitted through contact with the virus. It can be spread by droplets from a cough or sneeze, which can get into your mouth, nose, eyes, or lungs, or by contact with contaminated surfaces.

Prevention • Stay home. • If essential to go into a public setting, wear a mask and try to maintain six feet between yourself and other people. • Wash your hands often. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. • Cover your cough/sneeze with a tissue. Throw tissue away and clean hands. • Don't touch your eyes, nose, or mouth.

ADMINISTRATION UPDATES & NEWS:

NOTE: We've been doing our COVID-19 precautions for many months now and need to keep our efforts strong going forward to ensure everyone stays healthy. Anyone not following our guidelines puts all others at risk. It is essential that everyone uses the hand sanitizer before entering the Dining Room, this is not negotiable. Also, please wear your mask so that it covers your nose and mouth when outside of your room.

NOTE: From the Ombudsman: DC DMV Service Update: DMV has extended the expiration date for all documents expiring March 1 through the duration of the public health emergency, including driver licenses, identification cards, vehicle registration, inspections, ticket payments and ticket adjudication responses, until 45 days after the health emergency concludes. All driver licenses, vehicle registrations, and vehicle inspections scheduled to expire have been granted a waiver without penalty until DC DMV reopens at full operation capacity.
