- **GATE HOUSE:** Use the far right lane to swipe your key at the gate when entering AFRH.

- **CURRENT ANNOUNCEMENTS:**
- **SERVICE DOGS:** Service dogs are working animals and must remain focused on their handler at all times. - **WEST GATE/ANNISTON AVE:** Please note that the West Gate is designated for vendor deliveries only. Residents and staff are not permitted to enter or exit through this gate and must use the Main Gate for all access. If you have any questions, contact Security.
- **NOISE COURTESY:** To help reduce noise between apartments, residents are asked to place felt pads or protective covers on the legs of chairs and other frequently moved furniture. Moving furniture without padding can create significant noise for neighbors, especially in rooms below. Taking this simple step can make a big difference in maintaining a quieter, more comfortable environment for everyone.
