FACILITY NOTES & RESIDENT INFO:

- **GATE HOUSE:** Use the far right lane to swipe your key at the gate when entering AFRH.
- **WORK ORDERS:** Please call the CMI Help Desk to submit a work order.
- **STATE FLAG FLYING AT FLAGPOLE:** North Carolina, known as the “Tar Heel State”, was the 12th state to established statehood on 11/21/1789.

- **DON'T RUN OUT OF MEDICATIONS:** Residents are responsible to ensure that they have a fourteen (14) day minimum supply of medications at all times. It usually takes (5) business days to process medication requests from when they are dropped off (excluding federal holiday and weekends). We don't offer same day Wellness Clinic appointments for prescription renewals so plan accordingly and schedule an appointment before you run out. This is especially important during Hurricane Season.

CURRENT ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- **WEST GATE/ANNISTON AVE:** Please note that the West Gate is designated for vendor deliveries only. Residents and staff are not permitted to enter or exit through this gate and must use the Main Gate for all access. If you have any questions, contact Security.
- **SWEEPSTAKES SCAM CHECKS:** Residents are advised to be cautious of fraudulent checks claiming to be from Publishers Clearing House, including recent reports of checks with “claim numbers” and instructions to contact a claims manager. These checks are scams and should not be cashed or deposited, as they may result in financial loss. If you receive anything similar, please report it to staff immediately for assistance.
- **MEAL TICKET SALES:** Due to technical difficulties, meal ticket sales at the Security Desk in the Main Lobby is on hold until further notice. - **COMMISSARY BAG FEES:** Beginning April 6, military commissaries are charging a small fee for single-use bags: 5 cents for plastic bags and 10 cents for paper bags. This change is intended to help reduce operating costs and encourage the use of reusable bags.
