Medication Turnaround Time: We would like to remind everyone that when your prescription medication request is received, the standard turnaround time is 48 – 72 hours. This allows our pharmacy team to carefully review your medication history, ensure the availability of the medications, and prepare your prescription. We encourage residents to request refills at least 10 days before your medications run out.
